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The Draft National Spatial Development Framework (NSDF) is the first of its kind to be prepared in post-1994 South Africa. It seeks to deal with the eradication of the colonial and apartheid spatial legacies in a rational, orderly, and coordinated manner, and provides a long-term spatially focused developmental approach towards planning and land-use management in the country.

Throughout the extensive process of framework preparation, stakeholder engagement and consultation, Enterprises UP's team of planning, legal, GIS, engineering, economic development, governance and environmental specialists led by the University of Pretoria's Department of Town and Regional Planning provided support to the Department of Agriculture, Land Reform and Rural Development, custodian of the NSDF. The framework was prepared in terms of the Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act, 2013 (Act 16 of 2013) and approved for public consultation in 2019. On March 25, 2022, Cabinet approved the Draft National Spatial Development Frame (NSDF) for implementation. This achievement is only one example of Enterprises UP's spatial development planning competence.

Locally, Enterprises UP undertake precinct housing market and feasibility studies and regularly collaborates with other research organisations. Such partnerships have included providing regional development insight and capacity-building expertise in support of the District Development Model's "One-Plan Model". Of late, work in the complex interfaces of mining companies, government, communities, and space has been intensified with a focus on land reform and the development of viable regional and local economies in mining areas. Enterprises UP also boasts a Gauteng Premier's Building Safe Communities Award in the category for "Spatial and institutional development and management framework for the local suburb".
